The first medical mission trip since the pandemic

WITH ROBERT MORRIS UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

"Rewarding", "Eye-opening", "Inspiring". Those are some of the expressions used by the nursing students from RMU to describe their experience during this November's medical mission trip.



n November, we received a group of 9 students from Robert Morris University, Pittsburgh, USA. While five of them are in their final year to become certified nurses, four are currently studying to become Doctors of Nursing Practice.

We picked them up at the airport on November 10th, with their suitcases full of donations and hearts full of dreams and hope. After enjoying Ecuador's diversity in Quito, Mitad del Mundo and Mindo, the students got to discover the beautiful village of Canoa, right by the Pacific Ocean, where we spent the week to officially start the medical mission at Rio Canoa's community.

Every morning, we visited the families that had the most difficulties to reach the clinic. The goal was naturally to give them medical attention but most importantly, to share their everyday life and learn about their habits and culture. Those moments were the opportunity for the students and the members of the community to connect and share so much love and kindness.

We opened the clinic at the community's school every day from 1pm to 5pm. Between triage, exam rooms and pharmacy, the clinic is the **opportunity for the students to practice what they were taught in theory in school**. One of the main skill that they learn from this experience is adaptability as they need to find sustainable ways to help the patients without the means that they are used to work with.

We left Rio Canoa on Friday after giving all the donations to the families and celebrating with the members of the community around food, music, dances and games.
